

Copy of letter No.75602/F2/72/AD dated 25-11-1973 from the Secretary to Government, Agriculture (Forest) Department, Trivandrum.

Sub:- Forest contracts-Damages caused to Roads by contractors preventive measures-
Inclusion of a Clause in Agreement

Ref;- Your Letter C2-37614/71 dt.24-10-1971, 15-12-72 and 10-4-73.

With reference to your letter cited I am inform you that the following clause may be substituted for condition 40 in the supply contact agreement and added as condition No.29 in the sale coupe agreement. The subsequent conditions therein may be renumbered.

A. The contractor shall not make any damage to bridge or roads and private prosperities during collection and transport of timber or during unloading logs from lorries and stacking them on the road side and he shall be liable for any such damage. The decision of the Government regarding the amount of compensation payable for the damage caused shall be final and binding on the contractor and the government shall recover such damage from the contractor.

B. If the damage caused is in respect of any road under the control of the K.S.E.B The amount of compensation payable for such damage will be assessed jointly by the Range Officer concerned and the Asst. Engineer of the concerned division of the KSEB, their decision being final and binding on the contractor. In such cases the contractor shall be liable to pay the damage to the KSEB and the KSEB shall recover a such damage from the Contractor.
