ORDER

The annual ceiling for the reimbursement of Children Education Allowance /Hostel subsidy in respect of AIS officers fixed as per Government Order read as 1st paper above are revised in accordance with the clarification of Department of Personnel & Training vide OM read above as detailed below.

Annual Ceiling limit for Children Rs. 12000/Education Allowance per child
Hostel subsidy per child per month Rs. 3000/Revised Rs. 15000/Rs. 3000/Rs. 3750/-

2. The quarterly claim for the reimbursement of Children Education Allowance could be more than Rs.3750/- in one quarter and less than Rs.3750/- in another quarter subject to the annual ceiling of Rs.15000/- per child. These revisions are applicable with effect from 1st January 2011.
