ORDER

In the Go. read as the first paper above, it was ordered that the government servants who occupy government residential quarters in high range should pay rent at $7\,\%\%$ of the pay for the full occupation and $2\,\%\%$ of the pay when shared by more than two officers as laid down in G.O. fin. (C) 5-15223/51 dated 19-9-1952.

A doubt has since been raised by the director of Agriculture as to where the term "High Range "would include all hilly tracts class I and class II mentioned in appendix IX of K.S.R.. and whether the concession of recovery of rent at 7 ½% of the pay could be made applicable to government servants who occupy Government Quarters in all hilly tracts class I and class II

Government wish to clarify that the term High ranges mentioned in G.O. MS.275/63/PW dated 4-7-63 includes only I in Appendix IX of the K.S.R and that the Concession of recovery of rent at 7 ½% of the pay of the occupant is not applicable to governments who occupy government quarters in hilly tracts class II in the state.
