ORDER

In the G O read above sanction has been accorded to pay a rate of 37 paise for bundle of elephant fodder of 25 kgm. In respect of elephants of Konni Division .

2. The Chief Conservator of Forests as reported that the shortage of fodder for elephants is equally soute in Kodangad, where most of the reserves have been cleared for Eueslyptes and other plantations. It is also reported that all kinds of fodder are entirely lacking in Kodanad except caryote leaves. The Chief Conservator of Forests has therefore requested that t he existing rate of fodder charges viz. one mazdoor at Rs 2.50 per day for each elephant may be enhanced and has recommended that a rate of 37 paise per bundle of fodder of 25 kgm be cannot sanctioned to Malayatoor Division .

Government accept the recommendation of the Chief Conservator of Forests and order accordingly .
