ORDER

At present the fees collected for extra-curricular activities and caution money deposits collected in Educational Institutions are being deposited in Treasury Savings Bank Accounts in the name of the Heads of Institution concerned. The Accountant General in his letter read as 1st paper above has stated that, according to the instructions issued by the Comptroller and Auditor General, (read as 2nd paper above) the transactions relating to fees for extra curricular activities in Government Educational Institutions should be accounted for in the Public Account under a separate minor head "Deposits of Educational Institutions under "843 Civil Deposits" and that a separate account should be maintained in the treasury for each institution as in the case of P.D. Accounts.

- 2. Government have examined the question in all its aspects and are pleased to order that the existing system will continue for the current financial year also and that the P.D./Treasury Savings Bank account will be closed at the end of the year. Fresh accounts will be opened under the new minor head referred to above for this purpose from the next financial year.
 - 3. The Accountant General will issue necessary further instructions in this regard.
