## **ORDER**

The Forest Department as well as Kerala Tourism Development Corporation operate boat service at Thekkady. At present the Forest Department is levying boating charges in accordance with the G O read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above, and wide disparity exists in the rates levied by the Forest Department and KTDC. This has been causing operational problems, often leading to even law and order issues when there is great rush of visitors to the sanctuary. The rates fixed at present and are also not viable- In the circumstances, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Wildlife) has proposed to enhance the boating charges charged by the Kerala Forest Department in Thekkady at par with the rates charged by KTDC.

Government have considered the proposal in detail. Since both Forest Department and KTDC are offering comparable facilities, Government are pleased to enhance the boating charges in Thekkady operated by the Forest Department as detailed below with effect from 1-3-2012.
