ORDER

In the G.O. Read as 1st paper above, certain measures were ordered to be carried out for effecting economy in non-plan expenditure during this year. As further tightening of governmental expenditure was considered necessary for avoiding budgetary deficits and for containing the inflationary pressures in the economy, Government in G.O. read as second paper above ordered the adoption of more economy measures. In this G.O., a specific reduction of Rs.100 lakhs in the works expenditure for 1966-67 was also ordered pending a detailed department-wise review of the budgetary outlays.

2. Government have since conducted a detailed review of the budgetary outlays for each department and hereby order a total reduction of Rs.3.27 crores (including the sum of Rs.100 lakhs referred to in the G.O. dated 25-7-1966) in the budget provision for 1966-67. The Department-wise details of the reductions in outlays made in respect of "Expenditure other that Works:, "Works expenditure" and "Expenditure under Q.Loans and Advances" are given in Annexure I, II and III respectively.

3. In regard to works expenditure, the extent of expenditure that can be reduced by staggering or postponing the works and by dropping budgeted items are also indicated.

4. All heads of departments and offices will ensure that the expenditure for the current year on the items given in the Annexures is so regulated as to keep it within the reduced outlays for the year. The above cuts should be reflected in the revised estimates to be sent to Government.

5. Government would also impress on all the officers about the need for avoiding supplementary demands for grants. Government desire that only in exceptional and unavoidable cases should supplementary demands for grants be moved.
