ORDER

In view of the need to curtail non-plan expenditure, Government order that a reduction of Rs.3.5 crores will be made in the non-plan expenditure for the current year as indicated below.

- (i) The following specific cuts are ordered in the budget provision.

- (ii) Grants and loans to local bodies will be disbursed only by adjustment against the amounts due from them to the Government. As a result there will be a reduction of Rs. 100 lakhs in the net outflow of funds.

- (iii) A three per cent cut will be imposed in the provision to Office Expenses of all Departments.
