Sub:- Economy in expenditure – Expenditure on Public functions - Restrictions of

Government have ordered in G.O.(P)387/75/Fin. Dated 27-8-1975 that no Expenditure on Public functions should be curtailed to the minimum and that all ceremonial functions should be conducted in an atmosphere of austerity. It has come to the notice of the Government that large amounts are even now being spent on public functions, especially by the public undertakings in the shape of costly pandals, illumination (at times when it is not a necessity) etc. All Heads of Departments will therefore ensure that the expenditure on public functions etc., is strictly curtailed to the bare minimum, including those relating to the public undertakings under their control.
