## ORDER

At present different procedures are being adopted in the Kozhikode Circle and in Chalakudy and Quilon Circles for the Inspection of Depots by the Divisional Forest Officers. It is necessary to have uniformity in conducting inspection of Depots by the Divisional Forest Officers. The Chief Conservator of Forests has reported that the procedure followed in Kozhikode Circle results in great economy in correspondence, savings in T.A. and avoidance of over lapping tours and that it might be copied in Chalakudy and Quilon Circles also.

- 2. The Accountant General who was consulted in the matter has reported that audit has no objection to the adoption of the Malabar Procedure.
- 3. In the circumstances, Government are pleased to order that the procedure for the inspection of Depots by the Divisional Forest Officers followed in Kozhikode circle will be adopted in Chalakudy and Quilon circles also.
