It has come to the notice of the Chief Conservator of Forests that the Divl. Forest Officers and Conservator of Forests are sanctioning or submitting estimates for various works invariably admitting or recommending the maximum rates provided in the schedule of rates, though there is adequate room for reducing the rates in some cases considering the amount of work involved. In this connection the Conservator of Forests are reminded that the schedule of rates are the maximum rates admissible for the entire state and Divl. Forest officers and conservators should b reduce the rates according to local conditions. The expenditure should be reduced to the barest minimum cutting down rates or not providing for any avoidable items. The Divl. Forest offices and Conservators should strictly follow the above orders while sanctioning and submitting estimates.
