As per Rule 140 (b) Kerala Service Rules, Part I a transfer to foreign service requires the sanction of Government. Note 2 below Rule 144, insists on previous consultation with Finance Department for any order permitting transfer to foreign service. The above powers have not been delegated to any authority subordinate to Government. But instances have come to the notice of Government that orders sanctioning deputation to foreign service are being issued by the Heads of Departments/Offices and Government wish to emphasise that such act is treated as contravention of the relevant provisions and rules. All Heads of Departments/Offices are instructed to strictly abide by the rules and to refrain from issuing orders sanctioning deputation to foreign service.
