Public Services- Officers selected for training Overseas- Period of journey for Medical examination to be treated as leave in cases where candidates are found medically not right.

O R D E R

An instance has come to the notice of Government where an officer sponsored by Government for training in a foreign country was found unsuitable according to the standards of health prescribed for stay in the foreign country. The period taken for the journey to the Medical Examination centre in India and back was consequently treated as duty even though the training did not materialize in his case. The Government direct that in future in cases where an officer selected for training is found unsuitable on medical examination or other wise, etc., in connection with the training, will be treated as leave and that no T.A. will be allowed for such journeys.
