O R D E R

In Partial modification of the provisions in Rule 91 in Part I of the K.S.R., the Government are pleased to order as follows:-

1. The minimum service required to render an officiating or temporary officer in a non-technical Department eligible for leave for higher studies is reduced to two years from five years.
2. The concessions available to officiating or temporary Medical Officers under the latter part of the Rule are extended to technical officers of other technical Departments like Engineering, Veterinary and Agriculture.
3. Finance Department will take steps to amend the rule accordingly.
