NOTIFICATION

G.O.(P) No. 907/97/Fin. Dated, Thiruvananthapuram, 24th October, 1997.

S. R. O. No. 856/97.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Services Act, 1968 (19 of 1968) read with section 3 thereof, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following rules further to amend the Kerala Service Rules, namely:

RULES

(C. S. No. 2/97)

1. Short title and Commencement.—(i) These rules may be called the Kerala Service (Amendment) Rules, 1997.

(ii) They shall come into force at once.

2. *Amendment of the Rules.*—In Part I of the Kerala Service Rules after Rule 55, the following rule shall be inserted, namely:—

“55 B (i). Notwithstanding anything contained in rule 55, when an officer is placed under suspension while on leave without allowances, he shall not be eligible for any subsistence allowance during the period of the leave. On the expiry of the leave if he continues to be on suspension, he shall be entitled to the subsistence allowance. If he is re-instated before the expiry of the leave, he shall continue to be on leave till its expiry, unless the officer otherwise desires.

55 B (ii). In the case of an officer on leave with allowances the orders of suspension shall have the effect of cancelling the leave for the period of suspension. He shall be entitled to subsistence allowance.”

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

According to the existing rules when an officer is suspended while on leave without allowances, he becomes eligible for subsistence allowance. Now the Government have decided that if an officer is suspended during the period of leave without allowances he will not be eligible for subsistence allowance or any other allowances during the period of such leave.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
