ALLOWANCE - COMPENSATORY ALLOWANCE – PENSION ATTACHED TO SECRETARIES TO GOVERNMENT ETC - CLARIFICATION OF ORDERS ISSUED

ORDER

In the G. O read as 2nd paper above Government have sanctioned a compensatory allowance of Rs.10 (Rupees Ten only) per month to the peons posted with the officers whose stenographers are in receipt of the compensatory allowance of Rs. 20 sanctioned in the G.O first cited. A few Departments have sought clarification on the following points:-

1. Whether more than one peon working under the same officer would be eligible for the allowance sanctioned in the G.O. second cited.

and

2. Whether Duffadars are also eligible for the above allowance.

Government has examined these aspects and are pleased to issue the following clarifications:-

1. The allowance can be paid to more than one Peon working under the same officer, if they too have work out of office hours and on holidays.
2. Duffadars are last grade servants and they are in the scale of pay of higher grade peons. It therefore follows that if they have to work out of office hours and on holidays as peons, they are also eligible for the allowance.
