## **AMENDMENT**

In Part I of the said rules, the following shall be inserted as a note in Clause (33) under rule 12.

"Note. When a special pay is granted in lieu of a higher time scale such special pay will also count as substantive pay provided the officer holds a lien on the post to which thee special pay is attached." (This amendment shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from 1-11-1959).
