According to Sub rule 2 of Rule 9, if drugs essential for the effective

treatment of a patient entitled to free medical attendance are not available in the

Government Medical Institutions, they may be purchased from the open market and the

expenditure incurred thereon reimbursed to the Government servant. In this connection,

Government are pleased to clarify that when the husband and wife are Government

servants, if the question of reimbursement comes, the reimbursement pertaining to the

medicines purchased for the husband should be claimed by him and that pertaining to the

wife by her. If the reimbursement pertains to medicines purchased for any other member

of the family, the claim should be made by the husband, if he is living and by the wife

when the husband is no more so that there will be no duplication of claims.
