ORDER

Sri. M.A.Divakaran a Forest Guard in the Trichur Forest Division was absent from duty from 5-4-1965 to 7-5-1967. He was undergoing the Diploma Course in Ayurvedic Medicines during this period. He had applied for leave for study purpose. But he was not eligible for leave for study purpose as the superior qualification, for acquiring which, he had applied for leave was not one which either enhanced his usefulness as member of the Forests Departments or improved his prospects in the Department. But the Divisional Forest Officer, Trichur allowed him to avail of the leave without considering the question of this eligibility for such leave. The Divisional Forrest Officer also admitted the guard to duty when he reported after expiry of the leave. The action of the Divisional Forest Officer was irregular and he has been warned against repetition of such irregularities.

- 2. The Chief Conservator of Forests has proposed that the period of absence of Sri. Divakran may be regularized by granting him eligible leave and leave without allowance as special case.
- 3. The proposal of the Chief Conservator of Forests is sanctioned in relaxation of Rule 91 part I.K.S. Rs. Especially because the Guard belongs to a scheduled casts.
