### ORDER

In the context of the strike by a section of the Government employees in January – March 1973, the Government in accordance with the G.O.first read above allotted 1053 candle dates from the District- wise ranked lists of the Kerala Public service Commission for appointment as Lower Division Clerk and 105 Candidates from the ranked lists of Higher Grade Typists for appointment as Lower Division Typists in offices where the attendance was less than 25% of the authorized strength. The allotment was made strictly on the basis of ranks in the public Service commission lists without following communal reservation etc. Out of the above only 309 Lower Division Clerks and 38 Lower Division Typists were actually entertained. By the orders cited the sub- para (viii) of the G.O.Second read above read with the G.O fourth cited, these provisional hands were ordered to be continued in service as such until further ordered to be continued in service as such until further orders. The question of regularization of their services has been under the consideration of Government for some time. After consider ting all aspects, Government are pleased to issue the following orders:-

i. The Service of the provisional hands now in position mentioned above, will be regularized with effect from the dates of their provisional appointments and they will be given seniority in accordance with their ranks in the public Service Commission list, without following communal rotation. The appointing authorities concerned will issue orders accordingly in respect of all such hands (including surplus hands) in the order of seniority as above, after due verification of their character and antecedents

ii. On regularization, they will be ranked above those who were appointed after 5-3-1973 (dated of withdrawal of strike) on the basis of the advice of the Public Service

Commission (which follows communal rotation etc.) irrespective of their ranks in the Public Service Commission lists.

iii. On regularization they will be absorbed in the available vacancies according to their seniority. The Heads of Departments/ appointing authorities concerned will forward to Government in Public (SS) Department a list in duplicate of surplus hands, if any, as in the proforma enclosed for reallocation to other Departments giving them seniority as in (i) and (ii) above. Until they are reallocated to other Departments, they will continue in their present Departments.

iv. Some of the Provisional; hands were relieved from their former departments on receipt of the advice of the Public Service Commission and joined duty in other Departments. Their request to go back to their former departments will not be allowed. The request of provisional L.D. Typists for appointment as Higher Grade Typists in the Secretariat etc, will also be allowed.

2. In order to rectify certain anomalies which occur in the appointments made during the period of the strike, Government ordered in para 2 of the G.O.third read above them the candidates who secured higher ranks in the Public Service Commission lists than those who were appointed provisionally in the contests of the strike, but in whose cases the orders of appointment could not be issued, would be given the same benefits as admissible to provisional hands under the G.O.first read above as regards absorption in Government service. There are 346 persons eligible for appointment as Lower division Typists in terms of the G.O.third read above. A few among them might have been advised by the Public Service Commission from 5-3-1973 to 15-12-1973 (the date of expiry of period of the list) in the normal course and appointed in service. The Government have decided that the remaining persons will be appointed in Government service giving them ranks with reference to the date of their appointments in service. Their appointment in the first instance will be temporary pending verification or character and antecedents and the appointment will be regularized only after verification- Vide the proviso to Rule 10 (b) of K.S. & S.S.R.Part I. If more than one person is appointed in a Department, the inter-se-sonority among them will be in accordance with their ranks in the public Service Commission list.

3. To enable the appointment in service of the persons mentioned in para 2 above, Government direct that the Heads of Departments will report to Government in the Public (SS) Department the vacancies of lower Division Clerks (District – wise basis) and Lower division typists instead of reporting them to the Public Service Commission, until further orders.
