NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Kerala hereby makes the following further amendments to the Kerala Service Rules, namely:---

AMENDMENTS

C.S.No. 9/62, DATED 30th March 1962.

In Part I of the said Rules, in Rule 90A(1) after the existing clause (d), the following shall be inserted as clause (e), namely:-

- (e) The allowance in the case of an officer in temporary employ will be limited to a maximum period 18 months and that in the case of a permanent employ to a maximum period of 36 months in all during his entire service.”

In Note I, for the words “eighteen months will be admissible the words “ eighteen months or thirty six months, as the case may be, will be admissible” shall be substituted.
