NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Kerala hereby makes the following amendments to the Kerala Service Rules, namely:--

AMENDMENTS

C.S.No. 33/63.

In Part I of the said Rules, in rule 31 the existing Note shall be numbered as Note 1 and after Note 1 as so numbered the following shall be inserted as Note 2, namely:--

“Note 2. An Officer shall not be eligible for an increment unless he has acquired the obligatory departmental test qualifications, if any, prescribed by Government from time to time to earn the increment.

This amendment shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from 1-11-1959.
