ORDER

Sri. D. Chithambarathanu Pillai, Lower Division Clerk, Forest Department was granted extraordinary leave for more than 7 months at a stretch by the Divisional Forest Officer, Kozhikode. The clerk had then completed only 2 months services and he was also not a permanent employee. He was not therefore eligible for the leave granted (Vide Rule 88 Part I K.S.Rs.)

The Chief Conservator of Forests has stated that the Divisional Forest Officer, Kozhikode has realized his mistake and has requested to be excused. He has therefore requested that the Divisional Forest Officer's action may be ratified.

In the special circumstances of the case, the action of the Divisional Forest Officer, Kozhikode in having granted extraordinary leave to the clerk from 5-12-1961 to 29-7-1962 is ratified as a special case in relaxation of rule 88(11) Part I, K.S.R. The Divisional Forest Officer is warned against the repetition of such irregularities.

The Chief Conservator of Forests will see that such flagrant violations of rules are not repeated in future by the officers of his department.
