ORDER.

Sri. T.C. Pathrose, a Ranger retired from service on 14-10-1964. He had applied for leave preparatory to retirement on 6-6-1964. But the leave applied for was 'refused' by the Chief Conservator of Forests as his services were essential for the conduct of a case. However, he was granted leave with affect from 4-10-1964 on which date he was eligible for 60 2/11 days of earned leave. On 14-10-1964 he had availed of only 11 days of earned leave. The action of the Chief Conservator of Forests in having refused the leave preparatory to retirement to Sri. T.C. Pathrose is irregular as Government alone are competent to 'refuse' leave.

2.However, as the services of Sri. Pathrose were reported to have been absolutely essential, Government are pleased to treat the earned leave at the credit of the Ranger on the date of his retirement as 'refused leave' under Rule 75 Part I K.S.R. and to extend the benefits of such refused leave to the retired Officer.

3. The action of the Chief Conservator of Forests in having refused the leave is also ratified.
