ORDER

Under paragraph 3(a) of the Government order read above officers who take earned leave for a period of not less than thirty days will be allowed to surrender once in twelve months an equal period of earned leave, if due and admissible, subject to a maximum of thirty days and will be sanctioned leave allowance for the leave so surrendered.

2. In view of the difficulties created by compulsorily going on leave by officers for purpose of surrender, Government have examined the question in detail and consider that the requirement to avail thirty days earned leave for purpose of surrendering an equal period of earned leave, be dispensed with, accordingly in modification of the orders in para 3 (a) of the G.O. read above, Government are pleased to order that officers will be allowed to surrender earned leave, if due and admissible, subject to a maximum of thirty days once in twelve months and will be sanctioned leave allowance for the earned leave so surrendered without availing of earned leave.
