Sub: -- Regulation of increment from the first date of the month—further modification issued.

Ref:-- (i) G.O. (P) 91/74/Fin. dated 5-4-1974.

(iii) Letter No. TM. II/12-28/Pay.Vol.XVIII/108/706. dated 26-8-1975 from the Accountant General, Kerala.

In the Circular read above some clarifications were issued in respect of the regulation of increment from the first date of the month ordered in G.O. (P) 91/74/Fin. dated 5-4-1974. To make the position stated in Para (ii) of the circular more accurate the following modifications are issued changing the dates given therein:--

“When the date of appointment of an employee is 19-4-1973, can he/she be given increment on 1-4-1974 before completing 12 months service? Similarly when he/she is promoted to a higher grade on 19-4-1973, can he/she get increment on 1-4-1974 before completing 12 months in the officiating grade?”

In the case of initial appointment/promotions occurring after 1-4-1973, it is inherent in the order first cited that the first increment will be drawn earlier before completing the normal incremental period of 12 months”.
