Till now, the Wild Life Department was functioning under the Conservator of Forests Chalakudy Circle. Now that Works in connection with Wild Life Preservation are being carried out in more than one Circle, the existing arrangements are found to be unsatisfactory as the Wild Life Preservation Officer has to work under more than one Conservator of Forests. So, with a view to make the administration more efficient hereafter, the Wild Life Preservation Officer will work directly under the Chief Conservator of Forests.

- 2. Only matters dealing with disposal of tree growth, i.e., fixing up of contracts for collection/sale of trees falling within the sanctuary will be dealt with by the respective Conservators. All other matters including Civil Works in the Wild Life Department will hereafter be dealt with by the Chief Conservator of Forests. The Wild Life Preservation Officer will submit his diaries, tour journals, T.A. bills etc., to the Chief Conservator of Forests in future.
