ORDER

The Chief Conservator of Forests has suggested that a time limit of two months from date of detection may be prescribed within which forest cases should be charged before courts. The suggestion of the Chief Conservator of Forests is accepted. Government also order that if in any event it is not possible to charge the case in court within this limit the Conservator of Forests will grant permission to charge the case after investigating the causes for delay.
