Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

The Government of India have suggested that each State should have its own State Animal /Bird/Tree. The State Wild Life Advisory Board in its meetings held at Thekkady on 18-2-1983 and at Munnar on 6-5-1983 selected the Indian Elephants, the Great Indian Horn Bill and the Coconut tree as the State animal, bird and tree respectively. Government accepted the recommendation of the State Wild life Advisory Board. The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
