According to orders in the G.O. read as first paper above, special casual leave not exceeding 6 days for men and 14 days for women is allowed to all Full Time Contingent Employees and Work Establishment staff for undergoing sterilization operation.

The Director of Health Services, in his letter cited, has proposed to extend the above benefit to the Part Time Contingent Employees also, in view of the fact that the Family Planning Programme is of National importance.

Government have considered the proposal and are pleased to order that the benefit of special casual leave sanctioned in the G.O. read as 1st paper above will be extended to all categories of Part Time Contingent Employees including those on consolidated remuneration.
