In the Government orders cited Government have ordered that as far as possible officers posted to work in Linguistic Minority areas should be persons who possess adequate knowledge of the minority language. Government have also permitted correspondence with Government offices in minority languages. The Heads of Departments are therefore requested to see that as far as possible and subject to availability of officers having requisite knowledge of the minority language, replies to petitions received by them in minority languages are given in that very language itself. They are also requested to issue necessary instruction in this regard to their subordinate officers.
