ORDUR.

Among the various measures laid down in the G.O. readahove for effecting economy in public expenditure, special mention has been made that tours outside the state especially to Delhi should be restricted to the minimum.

- 2. Formerly officers of the technical departments who wanted to participate in conference outside the state and would be of assistance to them professionally were being permitted to attend such conferences, T.A. and D.A. being allowed to them in exceptional cases. With a vi w to effecting economy under T.A. it is felt necessary to lay down certain guiding principles to regulate the deputation of officers to attend conferences, seminars etc. outside the state at Government cost. Accordingly the following instructions are issued.
 - ii. Where the some other agency is willing to meet the cost and if there is no bjection to permitting it, the participation being held beneficial either to the department or the officer concerned professionally, the officer may be allowed to go at the cost of the outside agency without any claim to T.A./D.A. from the Government.
 - i. Where the participation of an officer in the conference, seminars etc. is clearly to the benefit of the department and the cost will not be met by any sponsoring or outside agencies, deputation can be sanctioned at Government cost, subject to availability of funds.
 - iii. Where such participation is not clearly to the benefit of the department as a whole, but might be useful to the officer professionally, and cost will not be met by any outside agency, the officer may be permitted to attend at his own expenses, subject to exigencies of service.
 - 3. The period of absence of the officers coming under categories (ii) and (iii) above will be treated as on special casual leasuch leave being sanctioned by the competent authority. The period of deputation under item (i) above will alone be treated as duty.
