In the G. O. read as the first paper above, as amended by the Government Orders second to fourth cited, Government have issued the rules for the constitution of Staff Councils. In his letter read above, the Chief Engineer (General, Buildings & Roads) has, interalia, sought for clarification whether the nomination paper filed by the candidate for contesting the election for any category of staff in the Staff Council should be proposed and seconded by members of the same category and class alone. Government consider that the said rules have to be amended to make this point clear. Accordingly they are pleased to order that clause (iii) of rule 12 of the said rules be amended by adding the following sentence at the end of it, namely:—

"The candidature in a particular category shall be proposed and seconded by the members of the same category".
