Passport - Revised procedure for submitting passports -
applications of Government Servants - Instruction issued.

CIRCULAR

The Regional Passport Officer, Madras has informed Government that the procedure hitherto followed for submitting passport applications of Government Servants has been modified. According to the modified procedure intimated by the Regional Passport Officer, Government Servants requiring ordinary passports should normally route the passport applications through their employers and the latter while forwarding their applications to the Regional Passport Officer, should certify that there is no objection to the grant of passport and also indicate whether the applicants are permanent or temporary employees. If for any reason, the application is filed direct to the Regional Passport Officer a 'No objection certificate' from the employer should be furnished before a passport is given.

2. In order to avoid complications in the matter, Government authorise the Heads of Departments to forward to the Regional Passport Officer, the passport applications of the Government Servants in their respective Departments and to issue 'No objection certificates'. Passport applications of Heads of Departments should be routed through the concerned Administrative Departments in the Secretariat, and No objection Certificates in such cases may be issued by the concerned Administrative Departments in the Secretariat. The procedure intimated by the Regional passport Officer, indicated in para 1 above should be followed by the Heads of Departments and the Departments in the Secretariat, while forwarding the passport applications of the Government Servants to the Regional Passport Officer.

The Regional Forest Officer, Madras has informed Government that the procedure for the grant of existing passport applications of Government servants has been modified. According to the modified procedure introduced by the Regional Forest Officer, Government servants who are ordinarily on leave should normally route their passport applications through their employers and the latter while forwarding their applications to the Regional Forest Officer, should certify that there is no objection to the grant of passport and also indicate whether the applications are for permanent or temporary employees. For any reason, the application is filed direct to the Regional Forest Officer, the Regional Forest Officer should be informed before a passport is granted.

3. In order to avoid complications in the matter, Government hereby direct the Heads of Departments to forward to the Regional Forest Officer, the passport applications of the Government servants in their respective Departments and to issue 'No objection certificate'. Passport applications of Heads of Departments should be cited through the concerned Administrative Departments in the certificate and no objection certificate in which cases may be issued by the concerned Administrative Departments in the certificate. The procedure indicated by the Regional Forest Officer, indicated above should be followed by the Heads of Departments and the Departments in the certificate, while forwarding the passport applications of the Government servants to the Regional Forest Officer.
