ORDER

Government have, in the Government Order read as first paper above, issued orders allowing the benefit of higher grade, with effect from 1-7-1979, to all Non-Gazetted Officers who remain in the entry grade without promotion in the normal course, on completion of 13 years of service in that grade. In the Government Order read as second paper above, Government issued detailed instructions for the implementation of the orders contained in the Government Order read as first paper above. Some of the service organizations of the employees of the Aided Schools, Private Colleges, Etc., have represented that the benefits granted to the Government employees in the Government Orders read above, may be4 extended to the non-teaching staff of the Aided Schools, Private Colleges etc., also.

2. Government, after examining the question in detail, are pleased to order that the benefit of higher grade promotion granted to Government employees on completion of 13 years of service in the entry grade as per the Government Orders read above, shall be extended to the non-teaching staff of the corresponding grades in Aided Schools, Private Colleges and Private Polytechnics, who come under the scheme of direct payment of salary by Government, on the same terms and conditions specified therein.

3. These orders will have effect from 1-7-1979.
