## ORDER

In the Memorandum read above, it has been requested that the Central Government Rules with regard to the grant of Maternity Leave to female officers may be adopted in the State also. As per Rules 43 (i) of the Central Civil Services (Leave) Rules, 1972, maternity leave can be granted for a period of 90 days from the date of its commencement.

2.Government have examined the proposal and are pleased to order that the Central Government rule will be adopted here also. Accordingly a competent authority may grant to a female officer under the State Government maternity leave on full pay for a period of 90 days from the date of confinement as at present.

- 3. There orders will take effect from the date of this order.
- 4. Necessary amendment to the Kerala Service Rules will be issued separately.
