ORDER

Government are pleased to order, that the rates of Dearness Allowance sanctioned in the G.O. read as third paper above will be revised with effect from 1st April, 1981 as above in the

2. In the case of those who remain in the pre-revision (1970) scales of pay, the amount of Dearness Allowance will be celebrated as already ordered in the G.O. read as second paper above, the rates of Dearness Allowance admissible for increase in the cost of living inter beyond 272 points, being replaced by the rates specified in the Annexure to this order.

3. The rates of Dearness Allowance of Part-time teachers and part-time employees sanctioned in the G.O. read as third paper above will also be revised as follows

1. These orders will apply to the full-time State Government employees, staff of Aided Schools, Private Collages and Poly techniques, full-time employees dearness contingency and work charged establishments and employees of local bodies, subject to the condition that the expenditure on this account is in respect of local bodies will be met from the funds of the respective local bodies.

5. In the G.O. Read as third paper above, the state Service Pensioners were allowed Dearness Allowance at 37.5% of their pension subject to a minimum of Rs. 38/- and a maximum of Rs. 188/- per annum with effect from 1-2-1981. Governments are new pleased as order that the State Service Pensioners will be allowed Dearness Allowance at 40% of their pension subject with effect from 1-1-1981. The increase in Dearness Allowances now allowed will be applicable to the Family Pensioners and such other pensioners to whom the orders contained in the G.O. read as first paper above were extended.

The minimum pension inclusive of Dearness Allowance will be Rs. 125/- and the Minimum family pension inclusive of Dearness Allowance will be Rs. 100/- with affect from 1-4-1981.
