ORDER

Government are pleased to issued the following guidelines in the matter of late attendance by Government Servants.

- (1) Since adequate leave facilities exist on a liberal scale the facility to be late with permission", will not be allowed.
- (2) Three late attendance shall lead to loss of one day's casual leave.
- (3) The computation shall be on an annual basis.
- (4) Forfeiture of Casual Leave for late attendance shall not be a substitute for disciplinary action which can be initiated, if necessary on the merits of individual cases.
- (5) If there is no casual leave at the credit of the employee, earned leave or half pay leave or leave without allowance will be forfeited, the employee being permitted to choose the kind of leave to be forfeited. Forfeiture will be effected by the grant of leave for the third day of late attendance.

The Heads of Offices shall be held personally responsible for the enforcement of the above instructions. Allowing or condonation of late arrivals is specifically prohibited.
