## ORDER

Typist in the non Secretariat departments are now having the following three grades.

Lower Division on Rs. 640-1000 Upper Division on Rs. 740-1245 Senior Grade on Rs. 825-1430

In the general pay revision order read as first paper above, the ratio between lower division and upper division typists was fixed as 1:1 w.e.f. 16-9-1985. Promotion to senior grade is admissible only under the scheme of time bound grade promotion. Government have examined the question of improving the promotion prospects of typists in the non- Secretariat departments. They are pleased to order that in modification of the orders in the G. O. read as first paper above , the ratio of 1 :2:2 will be fixed among senior grade, upper division and lower division in non- Secretariat departments.
