ORDER

In the G.O. read as first paper above orders were issued revising the rate of conveyance allowance to physically handicapped employees in full time service from Rs. 75 to Rs. 100 per mensem with effect from the date of that order. Subsequently as per the G. O. read as second paper above the rate of conveyance allowance to the physically handicapped part-time employees was also revised from Rs. 35 to Rs. 50 per mensem with effect from 1-4-1988. Several representations have been received by Government to give effect to the revision of rates allowed to the part-time employees also from 15-6-1987.

Government have examined the question in detail and are pleased to order that revision of the rates of conveyance allowance sanctioned to the physically handicapped part-time employees in the G. O read as second paper above will be deemed to have come into force from 15-6-1987 as in the case of physically handicapped employees in full time service.
