By the G.O. Refereed to as first paper powers have been delegated to Heads of Department s to sanction temporary withdrawals from provident Fund up to a maximum of Rs 500/- in cases requiring special sanction. The comptroller has suggested that cases which require special sanction may be specified so as to avoid confusion. The Government accordingly direct that the following will be treated as cases requiring special sanction.

- (1) When 12 months have not elapsed after the repayment of the previous advance;
- (ii) When the advance exceeds three months pay of the subscriber (six months) pay in the case of those governed by the Cochin General Provident Fund Rules; and
- (iii) When a previous loan is outstanding under the General Provident Fund (Madras) Rules.
