Kerala Service Rules- Sanctioning of Pension- Condoning the delay in the submission of application.

O R D E R

According to Rule 150 Part III K.S.R an ordinary pension is payable from the date on which the pensioner ceased to be borne on the establishment or from the date of his application whichever is later.

The question has up for consideration, whether proposals for condoning the delay in the submission of application for pension should come to Government for Orders.

After having examined the quest, Government are pleased to issue the following as a ruling under Rule 150 part III K.S.R.

RULING

The object of the letter alternative is to prevent unnecessary delay in the submission of application. But the authority competent to sanction the pension may condone the delay when it is satisfactorily explained.
