The Accountant General in the letter cited has stated that new minor head of leave encashment benefits' may be incorporated under the head of account 2071 pensions and other Retirement benefits 01-Civil' to record the leave encashment benefits granted at the time of retirement, termination of service etc. Hitherto such leave encashment benefits were classified under the functional major heads under which the salary of the employees concerned was drawn. In order to adopt the authorized classification in account a new minor head '115 Leave Encashment Benefits may be opened under 2071 pensions and Other Retirement Benefits -01 Civil' in The Budge.

Government have examined the matter in detail have agreed to the suggestion of the Accountant General. The new minor head of account viz.115 leave encashment Benefits is being opened in the Budget for 2000-2001

All the Heads of Department /Chief Controlling officers are, therefore instructed to ensure that leave encashment benefits granted at the time of retirement/ termination of service etc. are classified under the newly opened minor head " 115 leave Encashment Benefits " below "2071-01' from 1-4-2000 on wards.
