ORDER

A doubt has been raised whether the term 'pension' occurring in Rule 77, Part 111, Kerala Service Rules includes temporary increase in pension also.

After having examined the question, Government are pleased to issue the following as a ruling Rule 77, Part 111, K.S.R.

The expression "sum actually received" occurring in Rule 77 has been used to indicate that the amounts received by the officer by way of pension or gratuity should be taken into account and, accordingly, in addition to pension and gratuity drawn by the deceased officer the temporary increase in pension should also be taken in to consideration for determining the amount of residuary gratuity payable under Rule 77.
