## GOVERNEMNT OF KERALA <u>Abstract</u>

Forest Department — World Food Programme Assisted Kerala Social Forestry and Tribal areas Development (Project No.2774) –Extension of the Programme to the eight Southern Districts also – sanction accorded.

## ORDER

Government, as per the G.O. read as first paper above, accorded sanction for the implementation of the Kerala Forestry and Tribal Area Development Project with the assistance of the World Food Programme (Project No.2774) in the six northern Districts of the State viz. Kasargod, Kannur, Kozhikode, Wynad, Malappuram and Palakkad. Subsequently Government submitted a proposal to the World Food Programme Authorities through the Government of India for the extension of the above project to the remaining eight Southern Districts of the State also.

The Review Mission of the World Food Programme (which visited the State from 30.9.90 to 9.10.90) held discussions with the State Authorities concerned and recommended the extension of the Project to the eight Sothern Districts. The Headquarters of the World Food Programme at Rome has in principle agreed to extend the Project to the Southern District of Kerala. The Director of Operations (World Food Programme) New Delhi has requested the State Government to take necessary steps on infrastructure facilities including provision of storage godowns, supply of necessary equipments, appointment of staff and provision of funds in the State Budget for the extension of the project.

When the project is extended to the eight Southern Districts, 110 Ranges will newly come into the operational area of the Scheme.

In the above circumstances Government are pleased to accord sanction for the implementation of the Kerala Forestry and Tribal Area Development Project in the remaining eight Southern Districts of Kerala, pending final approval of the World Food Programme Headquarters. Sanction is also accorded for the creation of additional posts as detailed below, (subject to the condition that the posts will be filled up only after final clearance of the Scheme by the World Food Programme Headquarters Rome)
