## **ORDER**

In the G.O read as first paper above, Government had fixed the rate of interest on the deposits in the State Provident Fund (Travancore) and in the General Provident Fund (Cochin) at 4 percent per annum and on deposits in the work Establishments at Provident Fund and in the contingent Employee Provident Fund at  $3_{1/2}$  percent per annum. The above rates are in force with effect from 1-4-1952. In the G.O.read as second paper above the rate of interest in respect of deposits in the General Provident Fund (Madras), the C.P.F. (Madras) and in the C.P.P.F.(Madras) was fixed at 4 percent per annum for the financial year. 1962-63.

- 2. Government have since decided that with effect from 1-4-1963, the Government of India rates of interest on C.P.F.(C.S) deposits should be adopted for all types of Provident Funds administered by the Government irrespective of the fact whether the Fund concerned is contributory or non-contributory. Accordingly, they are pleased to order that interest at the rate of 4 percent per annum will be allowed on deposit and also on balance at the credit of the subscribers to the following Provident Funds on the 31<sup>st</sup> March 1963 and that this rate will be in force during the financial year beginning on 1<sup>st</sup> April 1963.
