ORDER

In the G.O.read as first paper above, orders were issued authorising the Accountant General to make payment of interest on the Provident Fund balance of a subscriber beyond a period of six months up to a period of one year, after he has personally satisfied himself that the delay in payment was occasioned by circumstances beyond the control of the subscriber and that administrative delays involved in the matter had been fully investigated and action taken. The above-mentioned orders were to be in force for a period of two years with effect from 1-7-1960. The benefit of the said orders was extended in the G.O.read as second paper above for a further period of one year with effect from 1-7-1962.

2. Now the State Government have decided that the benefit of the above orders should be extended to the subscribers for a further period of two years with effect from 1-7-1963 and they order accordingly.
