PROVIDENT FUND- TEMPORARY ADVANCES TO SUBSCRIBERS- COPIES OF SANCTIONS TO AUDIT- COMMUNICATION OF AS AND WHEN SANCTIONS ARE ACCORDED INSTRUCTIONS ISSUED.

In Circular No. 58287/60-1/Fin. (RG)4 dated 12-10-1960, instructions were issued to all Heads of Departments and Offices to communicate copies of sanctions for temporary advances from Provident Fund to the Accountant General as and when sanctions were accorded by them. In for C prescribed for according sanction for temporary advances from the General Provident Fund (Kerala) the Accountant General has also been included in the address entry for the communication of a copy of the sanction.

- 2. The Accountant General has now brought to the notice of government that in spite of the above instructions in many cases copies of sanctions are not communicated to him by the sanctioning authorities an and when sanctions are accorded by them with the result that he has to call for copies of sanctions from the Departmental Officers when payments come to his notice during audit.
- 3. All Heads of departments and offices are therefore requested to forward a copy of the sanction for the advance in each case to the Accountant General so as to enable him to watch the payments against the sanctions and to climinate the possibility of the debit remaining unaccounted in the subscriber's Provident Fund Account. Government also direct that the above instructions be strictly followed by all Heads of Departments and offices.
