PAY REVISION 1988 – ORDERS ON THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE V KERALA PAY COMMISSION ---- RECTIFICATION OF ANOMALIES -- ORDERS ISSUED

ORDER

In the Government Order read above, Government have issued orders implementing the recommendations of the V Pay Commission on scale of pay and allied matters of State Government employees. Following this, a number of representations have been received from Heads of Departments, Service Organisations and officials etc, regarding anomalies and allied matters arising out of pay revision. In respect of representations already examined, Government Issue the following orders modifying/supplementing the general Pay Revision Orders issued in the Government Order read above:

(i) Modified scales of pay allowed

The following post will be given special pay with effect from 1-7-1988.

- (iii) Special Scales/ Grades allowed
- (1) Indian Systems of Medicine-Medical Officer (Ayurveda):

Medical Officer (Ayurveda) appointed by promotion of Pharmacists, will be given the scale of Rs 1450-2825 as in the case of directly recruited degree holders, from 1-7-1988.

(2) Ayurveda College P. G. Unit Technician (Netra):

The incumbent of the post will be given the scale of Rs. 1370-2640 as personal scale with effect from 1-7-1988 against the sanctioned scale of Rs. 1330-2555.

(3) Public Works-Architectural Wing-Chief Architect:

The Senior most Architect having longer or comparable seniority in service as that of the senior most Chief Engineer in the civil wing of the PWD will be given the upgraded scale of Rs. 4435-5285 as personal scale against the sanctioned scale of Rs. 3175-4605, from 1-7-1988.

(4) Secretariat-Clerical Assistant:

For the purpose of computing the total service for 25 years higher grade to Attenders, Clerical Assistants, Binders and Drivers, their service in the last grade will be reckoned as was done previously in terms of G.O. (P) 889/86 (112) Fin dated 12-12-1986. This will be given effect to from 1-7-1988.

- (5) Health Services-staff nurses appointed from the cadre of A.N.M. (Junior P.H. Nurses):
- (i) They will be granted time bound grades admissible had they been continued as ANM, reckoning their entire service as ANM/Staff Nurse if their grades as Staff Nurses on or after 1-7-1988 were not advantageous (ii) their period of training as Staff Nurse will also be reckoned as qualifying service provided they had drawn full salary and earned increment for the period.
- (6) General Education:

Primary School Teachers (Selection Grade)/ Primary School Headmasters appointed as High School Assistants (Graduate Teachers) will be allowed to retain their cadre post

scales as personal scales and these will be discontinued as and when grades as admissible to HSAs under the normal rules are given to them.

(7) Various Departments-Time-bound grade promotion scheme:

The regular promotion grades generally have no uniformity and they vary from post to post and from department to department. These grades are determined with reference to the general qualifications and method of recruitment, functions assigned and area of jurisdiction and also departmental set up. On the other hand, the grades prescribed under the time bound scheme (para 10 of G.O. dated 1-11-1989) generally follows a standardized pattern. Those who have regular promotion posts, the time bound grades allowable for the prescribed period of service relate to the promotion posts and that only in cases where regular promotion posts are not available, the standard grades prescribed under the general scheme allowed. considering the basic principle that time bound grades are intended to avoid stagnation on the basis of the entry grade should be higher than what they actually held by virtue of the cadre promotion/time bound grade got earlier. Taking into consideration of these aspects, Government order that, when the incumbents of such posts do not have further promotion post with reference to the entry post and when the grade already given to them as 10/20 year. grade are equal to or higher than the standard time bound grade admissible under, the general scheme as per para 10 (i) or (ii) of the Government Order read above, they will be allowed the next scale above, their existing scale in the standard scales of pay as 20/25 year grade as the case may be. Two illustrations are given below:

If the incumbent is holding the second level promotion post of M.R. Superintendent on Rs. 1370-2640, the 25 year time bound grade allowable on the basis of above orders will be Rs.1450-2825 in the next higher scale above his second level promotion post of Rs. 1370-2640.

Here the first level promotion grade is equal to the 20 year time bound grade under the general scheme and there fore 20 year higher grade to be given in this case on the basis of the orders given above will be Rs. 1830-3485 ie, the next scale above his first level promotion post of Rs. 1650-3175.
