## **ORDER**

The Accountant General has pointed out that some Officers who were in occupation of rooms in Guest/Rest House in different months constituting fairly long duration of stay had enjoyed House Rent Allowance during the period of their stay. The Accountant General has therefore requested Government to consider the matter and issue matter suitable orders. Government after considering the matter in detail, issue the following orders.

- 1. Officers occupying Guest/Rest House/ Tourist Bungalows at their Headquarters of duty at normal or concessional rates for more than 15 days during a month will not be eligible for House Rent Allowance for the month.
- 2. An Officer transferred to a new station however will be eligible for House Rent Allowance for the first month. even if he/she stays in the Guest House/ Rest House/ Tourist Bungalow.
